## Michigan Audubon – The Jack Pine Warbler Member Magazine Guidelines for Authors and Photographers

Submit your ideas for the Jack Pine Warbler by emailing <a href="mailto:birds@michiganaudubon.org">birds@michiganaudubon.org</a>.

Authors are always given a byline and photographers credited for their work. Michigan Audubon reserves the right to use submissions in either print or electronic media.

Images are required to be a minimum pixel density of 300 pixels per inch (ppi) and formatted at no less than 7.5" x 10". If submitting multiple images, please put them in a zipped file prior to sending. Please keep file size to 5 MB or less.

Include a caption with each image. Include the subject, location, date, and photographer's name. Images submitted for consideration as cover art are required to include technical information about how the image was captured—equipment used, shutter speed, aperture, special lighting conditions, etc. Please provide a biographical sketch and contact information for the photographer. Send captions in a separate Microsoft Word document.

Articles must be 500 words or fewer, unless a higher word count is indicated in correspondence with Michigan Audubon staff. Please include a biographical sketch of 2 to 3 sentences which will appear with your article. Please include an email address for readers to contact you.

Unsolicited articles and images are welcome, but are not guaranteed to appear in Michigan Audubon publications.

Submit articles, images, and advertising for the *Jack Pine Warbler* no later than the 1st of the month 2 months preceding the publication date.
