Ruby-throated Hummingbirds can flap their wings 700 times in 10 seconds.

How many times can you flap your wings in 10 seconds? While someone keeps track of time, count how many times you can flap your arms up and down.

Peregrine Falcon Station

A Peregrine Falcon can fly up to 200 miles per hour.

How fast can you move? Have someone record how fast you can run this 20-yard distance. Use the conversion chart to determine your speed in miles per hour.
